- CRADLES is open to any high school, Adult Education, or post-secondary student in Clay County
- High quality childcare for children six weeks to age 5
- Subsidized care is available with qualifying parents paying a minimal fee (parents are responsible for providing diapers, formula and baby food)
- Student parents are required to attend parenting workshops offered on-site. These include:

 - *stress management
 - *career development
 - *finances
