Key Topics Discussed

A. Updates

1. ELAC Updates
 - a. There are no updates about a new ELAC Chair being appointed.
 - b. The July ELAC appointed committee meeting has been rescheduled for July 24th from 1:00 pm-3:00 pm

2. National News and Partner Updates

 - d. MA Rooney Foundation:
 - i. Anne shared that the Rooney Foundation has established new partnerships with Indiana University and Indiana Department of Education to expand an interactive dashboard (called "[Ed-Fi Database](#)" and developed by the [Dell Foundation](#)) statewide and with community organizations.
 - ii. This system will increase access to real-time student data and has the option to include pre-k data.

B. 2018 Workgroup Priorities

1. Help Me Grow (HMG)
 - a. Discuss the results of the readiness assessment.
 - b. Kristi will reach out to the national HMG office to arrange for one of their data team members to call in to our July meeting and share best practices with other states who have implemented HMG.
 - c. Kristi will also begin to develop a list and timeline of data tasks.



- d. The workgroup discussed a possible concern of data sharing and privacy. Eric agreed to review the previous white paper created by this group in 2015 and make any updates as needed.

2. ELAC Annual Report

- a. Reviewed the appointed Committee's feedback on the proposed outline and structure for the 2019 annual needs assessment.
- b. Workgroup will provide ELAC with clarifying examples of equity data at the July meeting (i.e. discussing trends based on race/ethnicity, income, special need populations, geographic areas, etc.)
- c. Workgroup reviewed the examples of ECE system building assessments from the links that were shared and will identify one to use as a cross-reference for how well Indiana is doing (based on the needs assessment).
- d. At the July meeting, the workgroup will split into two groups to begin to assess the scorecard and work on HMG.

C. Early Learning Indiana Data Center

1. Special Guest: Carol Rogers, Deputy Director and CIO, IU Business Research Center (IBRC), Kelley School of Business
 - a. Carol talked through this new interactive data center that IBRC is creating to display early childhood data. Datacenter.earlylearningin.org
 - b. Viewers will be able to take information from their interactive dashboard(s) and put it on their own websites.
 - c. Currently working to develop heat maps and information on childcare "deserts".
 1. Different layers are embedded, such as congressional districts and counties.
 2. Studying childcare hubs and factors that contribute to these hubs.
 - d. The center will include some historical data, most likely from ELAC.
 - e. ELI would like to partner with ELAC to align data and leverage our combined resources.

Action Items

1. Kristi will reach out to the national HMG office to arrange for one of their data team members to call in to our July meeting. Kristi will also begin to develop a list and timeline of data tasks.
2. All workgroup members will review the scorecards that were shared in Glip.
3. TCG will outline examples/clarification of scorecards and equity to share with ELAC.
4. Eric will review and update the data privacy white paper.
5. TCG will meet with Carol Rogers to discuss coordination of ELAC data with ELI's Data Center.
